

Blue Span Shenandoah Cabin

A romantic and private weekend getaway cabin with fantastic views of the Blue Ridge Mountains. The cabin borders the George Washington National Forest and overlooks the Shenandoah River. The cabin is complete with a freestanding fireplace for those special evenings.



This is a modern cabin that has two queen sized bedrooms, a full bath, and fully equipped kitchen including microwave and coffee maker. There is a freestanding fireplace in the great room with a sleep sofa. The great room has ample glass for you to enjoy the views while relaxing in front of a fire.

You can enjoy cooking out on the deck with the charcoal grill in the evenings while watching the colors of the sunset illuminate the Blue Ridge Mountains.

The views from the cabin are spectacular. See the sunrise over the Blue Ridge Mountains in the morning while enjoying a cup of freshly brewed coffee.

The Shenandoah River is but a short walk from the knoll where the cabin sits overlooking it. This stretch of the river is noted for outstanding smallmouth bass fishing.

The Shenandoah National Park is a short drive with excellent hiking trails and native brook trout streams.



Nearby is a host of recreational activities to include canoeing, tubing, hiking, and fishing. Also a number of tourist attractions are close by.

All pots, pans, utensils, and dinnerware are provided along with basic condiments required for a relaxing stay.

You must bring your own linens and towels or arrange for them to be provided for an extra fee.

Rates: \$140 a night weekends and \$115 a night for weekdays.

Directions

From Washington DC: Take I-66 west to Gainesville. US29 south to Warrenton and follow signs to US211 west to Skyline Drive. Proceed on 211 to Luray and take the US340 exit. Go south towards Luray approx. 1/4 mile and take 1st right on the bridge over the Hawksbill Creek. This is Mechanic Street. Go 3.4 miles until the road crosses the Shenandoah River and the Road comes to a "T". Turn right on S.. Page Valley Road and go exactly 6.1 miles. The Bealers Ferry Canoe Launch Road will be on your right and Grand View Drive will be on your left. Just prior to this there is another Grand View Drive at the Shenandoah Lodge Sign - Do Not Take - go to the second Grand View Drive. Go up the hill and the cabin is the second driveway on left with #458 on post.
